# Proposed Constitution and By-Law Changes Voted On

# By-Law 1:

- Accept the new Ontario Softball age divisions of U7, U9, U11, U13, U15
- There will be no U17 division. ISA will have an U18 division instead

# By-Law 9-1 (U9):
