Proposed Constitution and Bylaw Changes Voted On

Constitution & Bylaws:

Note that some changes are considered "clean-up" and therefore not voted on

Constitution Article 3 c):

- Amendment to allow higher competition teams (PWSA, OAS) to play up an age division in league play
- DECLINED
- Article 3 c) does not change

Constitution Article 5 h):

- Amendment to remove the requirement of the ISA Secretary keeping a file on team rosters. Instead, the Convenor is responsible for keeping all team rosters on file
- Amendment to change the wording that a Convenor "shall not" coach in his/her classification to "it is recommended" that Convenor not coach in his/her classification
- CARRIED

Constitution Article 9, #3:

- Amendment to increase the fine from \$25.00 to \$50.00 if a Centre does not have an individual team representative for **each** Centre team at the Coaches Meeting
- CARRIED

Constitution Article 10 B):

- Amendment to have the Umpire in Chief or Senior Umpire rule on protests at tournaments rather than the Convenor
- DECLINED
- Article 10 B) does not change

Entire Bylaw Document:

- Amendment to remove all mention of old division names—example Mixed Mites, Atom, Squirt, and so
 on, and replaced by appropriate "U"
- CARRIED

Bylaw 1 A) 3:

- Amendment to change submission date of Team Registration Forms from May 27th to May 31st
- Amendment that all Team Registration Forms must be submitted in a digital format
- Amendment which eliminates Team Registration Forms being sent to the Secretary. Instead, they are sent to the Convenor only. The Convenor is responsible for maintaining a digital folder of these Team Registration Forms during the season for easy reference if requested by the Executive
- CARRIED

Bylaw 1 B) 3:

- Amendment eliminating the 50% participation rule for U7
- Amendment eliminating the need for T Ball Players to be listed on the U9 roster
- CARRIED

Bylaw 1 C) AFFILIATED PLAYERS:

- Amendment to add a new section to Bylaw 1. Section is to be called 1 C) and pertains to AFFILIATED PLAYERS. Purpose is to have all information related to Affiliated Players in one section
- CARRIED

Bylaw 1 C) 5:

PROPOSED CHANGE I:

- Amendment to clarify a centre with 2 or more teams in a division CANNOT use members of the different teams as affiliated players
- CARRIED

PROPOSED CHANGE II:

- Amendment to allow a centre to use lateral movement within one age classification one (1) time per year per player
- DECLINED.

Bylaw 1 D) 1 NUMBER OF PLAYERS REQURIED:

- Amendment to add a new section to Bylaw 1. Section is to be called 1 D) and pertains to the NUMBER OF PLAYERS REQUIRED. It removes section Bylaw 1 B) 7; it moves to Bylaw 1 D) 1. However, the wording is changed so that a team can start a game with 8 players and finish with 8 players or less. The game does not have to be forfeited if there is an injury or ejection the drops the players below.

Bylaw 2 B) & E):

- Amendment to clean up wording pertaining to the maximum length of games
- CARRIED

Bylaw 2 I) 1):

- Amendment to make rained out games determined as completed games after 4 innings or 1 hour of play
- CARRIED

Bylaw 2 I) 4):

- Amendment to add a section stating that regular season games not completed seven (7) days before the yearend tournament, or playoffs, are considered a loss for both teams
- DECLINED

Bylaw 2 K):

- Amendment eliminating the requirement that players bat in the order in which they appear on the game report.
- CARRIED

Bylaw 2 O) 2:

- Amendment to clarify when U11 Boys/Girls can or cannot advance to home on a steal
- CARRIED

Bylaw 3 A):

PROPOSED CHANGE I:

- Amendment adding an exception for U11 Girls pitching. U11 Girls will pitch two (2) innings. For the third (3) inning on, an adult will pitch three (3) pitches.
- DECINED

PROPOSED CHANGE II:

- Amendment adding an exception for U11 Girls pitching. No walks. After the 4th ball, an adult pitcher steps in and completes the count (i.e.: finish out the strike count)
- CARRIED

Bylaw 4 B):

- Amendment that states the Convenor will determine the end of the year tournament format; it is not decided at the Coaches meeting by the teams
- CARRIED

Bylaw 4 H) 1:

- Amendment that adds the option of Round Robin tournaments
- CARRIED

Bylaw 4 H) 4:

- Amendment that allows the Home Team to be determined by the flip of a coin in split divisions
- CARRIED

Bylaw 7, 4:

- Amendment that eliminates Section 4 and 6. Section 4 now pertains to Game Reports.
- Game Reports must be complete and in a readable electronic format (4 A), must be signed by both coaches and umpire (4 B) and the Convenor deals with late/missing reports (4D)
- 4 C changes the Game Report being sent in by the Home Team rather than the Winning Team.
- CARRIED-4A, 4B and 4D
- DECLINED-4C-Game Reports continue to be sent in by the Winning Team

Bylaw 9, 1:

- Amendment to remove the use of the T in 3-pitch
- CARRIED
